The Eastern Maine Railway Company ("EMR") filed a Notice of Exemption ("Notice") in the above-captioned docket on October 6, 2022 regarding a planned acquisition and operation of a rail line owned and operated by the Central Maine & Quebec Railway US Inc., d/b/a Canadian Pacific ("CMQR") between approximately MP 109 Grindstone, ME (Penobscot County) and Mile 72.43 near Brownville, ME (Piscataquis County), including branch lines and other associated track between the end points, as well as incidental trackage rights.
