RESPONSE TO REQUESTS CONTAINED IN DECISION DATED SEPTEMBER 25, 2023 TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD

On September 25, 2023 the Board noted several issues regarding the Abandonment Exemptions filed in the above captioned matters. The Mohawk, Adirondack & Northern Railroad Corporation (hereinafter MAN) and the Lowville & Beaver River Railroad Company (hereinafter LBRR) hereby respond to the issues and requests that the record be supplemented with the facts and requests contained therein.

- 1. Regarding the ownership of the LBRR, it should be noted that pursuant to an agreement with the Lewis County Industrial Development Authority, the fee ownership of the property of the LBRR was returned to the LBRR on July 14, 2016 and has remained the property of LBRR ever since. A copy of the Deed to LBRR is enclosed herewith.
- 2. The 1.15-mile branch at Beaver Falls NY is included in the sale to Lewis County but was omitted in LBRR's filing. LBRR hereby requests that

its Notice of Exemption for Abandonment include the Beaver Falls Branch. This being the case the Branch would no longer need to connect to the interstate rail network.

- 3. The milepost endpoint for the Lowville-Croghan line is milepost 10.57 not 10.41.
- 4. Since the deed from Conrail to MAN indicates that the Lowville-Carthage line extends to milepost 58.1 (see enclosed Conrail deed) that should be where the line to be abandoned extends to.

Please let me know if you have any other questions or concerns about the filings.

WITNESSETH: That the Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00), the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and other good and valuable consideration, paid by the Grantee, does hereby remise, release, and quitclaim unto the Grantee, and the successors and assigns of the Grantee forever, all right, title and interest of the Grantor of, in and to the following described Premises:

ALL THAT CERTAIN property of the Grantor, together with all improvements thereon, being those portions of Grantor's lines of railroad known as the Carthage Cluster, situate in the Counties of Lewis, Jefferson and St. Lawrence in the State of New York, hereinafter referred to as "Premises" and described in Exhibit "A" and generally depicted in Exhibit "B" hereof.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING further as noted in Exhibit "A" hereof.

UNDER and SUBJECT, however, to (1) whatever rights the public may have to the use of any roads, alleys, bridges or streets crossing the Premises, (2) any streams, rivers, creeks and water ways passing under, across or through the Premises, and (3) any easements or agreements of record or otherwise affecting the land hereby conveyed, and to the state of facts which a personal inspection or accurate survey would disclose, and to any pipes, wires, poles, cables, culverts, drainage courses or systems and their appurtenances now existing and remaining in, on, under, over, across and through the Premises, together with the right to maintain, repair, renew, replace, use and remove same.

- (1) Should a claim adverse to the title hereby quitclaimed be asserted and/or proved, no recourse shall be had against the Grantor herein.
- Grantor shall not be liable or obligated to provide for or supply directly or indirectly, for money or otherwise, any type of utility service to Grantee, even if the Premises are supplied utility service or services from or through Grantor owned or Grantor retained utility service facilities at the time said Premises are conveyed to Grantee; and that if Grantor at its sole discretion elects to provide any utility service or services for money or otherwise to said Premises during the period during which Grantee is arranging at Grantee's own expense for provision of utility service or services direct from public utilities, Grantee shall have no continuing right to use such service or expectation that Grantor must continue to provide it. It is further understood that Grantee's use of any utilities that are supplied through Grantor's utilities or billed to Grantor by any public utility for Grantee's use shall be at the sole cost and expense of Grantee and if Grantee fails to relocate or arrange for a separation of utility services, Grantor may arrange for a separation of the utility services at Grantee's sole cost and expense.

TOGETHER with the appurtenances and all the estate and rights of the Grantor in and to said Premises, EXCEPTING and RESERVING and UNDER and SUBJECT and provided as aforesaid.






